What does the Foundation do?

The PA Farm Show Scholarship Foundation was established to assist Pennsylvania youth with the ever increasing costs of continuing their education. This program is especially, but not exclusively, designed to assist students who plan to study agriculture sciences.

The Foundation was established in 1993 after three companies generously gave over \$11,000 for the purpose of providing scholarships. Since then, the Foundation has awarded \$1.6 million in scholarships to 552 worthy 4-H and FFA youth.

Today, the Foundation is funded from donations, memberships, gifts and various fund raising activities. It is also partially funded from proceeds of the Junior Market Livestock Auction.

Junior Market Livestock Auction

4-H and FFA members have groomed, fed and trained their animals for competition. These members have worked all year to prepare for the Junior Market Show and Auction at the Pa Farm Show. While the attention is drawn to the champions, each market animal is sold in the auction. A percentage of the sale proceeds of each animal automatically goes to support the Scholarship Foundation. Purchase of an animal not only benefits the individual exhibitor, but also benefits future scholarship recipients.

Animal purchase— without possession: Each animal sold at the auction has a predetermined market value promised by a packer. The buyer pays the difference between market value and the final bid but still receives recognition for purchasing the animal.

Animal purchase— with possession: Some buyers prefer to pay the full price at the time of the auction and take possession of the animal. The buyer is responsible for the animal and its care after the sale.
